

The name Horsenden has been variously spelt, Horsenddun, Horsindune, Horsindon, Horsing Downe, Horsington and Horsenton over the last 7 or 8 centuries, and is thought to derive from the Old English *hors* *dun* or horses down. Another, probably more fanciful, theory is that the hill was named after the Saxon chieftain *Horsa* giving *Horsan dudn*.
